## CHAP. 561

### AN ACT

To create a commission to investigate the conditions under which manufacture is carried on in cities of the first and second class in this state, and making an appropriation therefor.

*The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Section 1. A commission of nine members is hereby created consisting of two senators to be appointed by the president of the senate, three members of the assembly to be appointed by the speaker of the assembly, and four other members to be appointed by the governor. Such commission shall investigate as speedily as possible the existing conditions under which manufacture is carried on in so-called loft buildings and otherwise in the cities of
